White Wines

1. Trivento Viognier (Argentina)

Delicate and succulent with enticing fruit flavours from the delightfully fragrant Viognier fruit

2. Pinot Grigio Villa Mura (Italy)

Dry and light in style with delicate floral aromas and a hint of almonds on the finish.

3. Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc (New Zealand)

Glorious fruit flavours such as gooseberrys make this wine go down like a treat

4. Chablis AC, Ropiteau (France)

A creamy chardonnay with mineral and flint flavours. Well balanced acidity with hints of honeysuckle

5. Sancerre AC, Roland Tissier (France)

Classic varietal gooseberry flavours, rich yet modern zesty style that is very smooth

Red Wines

6. Poco Mas Cabernet Sauvignon (Chile)

Clean, fresh blackcurrant and bramble fruit, medium-bodied with soft tannins on the finish.

7. Montebueno Rioja, Joven (Spain)

Fresh, clean red berry fruits are accompanied on the nose by a pleasant spicy character

8. Oyster Bay Pinot Noir (New Zealand)

Fragrant, soft and flavourful with aromas of ripe cherries, plums and sweet fruit tannins

9. Barolo Le Terre (Italy)

A powerful oaky red wine made from the classic Nebbiolo grape in Piemonte

10. St Emillion, Gran Cru (France)

A delightful fusion of fine merlot with the perfect balance of cabernet sauvignon

Rose Wines

11. Pinot Grigio Blush, Sartori (Italy)

Crisp, clean, summer fruit flavours and a style which is on the sweeter side of off dry

12. Sancerre Rose, Roland Tissier (France)

Powerful aromas of raspberries and cherries on the nose. It is dry and medium bodied

Sparkling Wines

13. Cava Brut, Pere Ventura (Spain)

Fresh, clean and fruity with great bubbles and refreshing acidity. A fantastic summer wine.

14. Cava Brut, Pere Ventura - Rose (Spain)

Exquisite red fruit flavours with a delightful, long-lasting aftertaste. Excellent party wine.

Champagne

15. Reynier Brut (France)

A distinguished champagne with fresh aromas and green apple character and dry, toasty notes.

16. Reynier Rose (France)

Wild strawberries on the nose give way to a powerful and well structured palate.

17. Veuve Cliquot Brut (France)

A blend of Pinot Noir for depth, Chardonnay for elegance, and Pinot Meunier for roundness, richness.

18. Veuve Cliquot Rose (France)

This champagne greets you with raspberry and strawberry aromas. What follows is intense and strong.

19. Laurent Perrier Rose (France)

Famous for its highly expressive bouquet with extraordinary depth and freshness. Benchmark rose.

20. Dom Perignon (France)

Scented with ambrosial honey and almonds, and full of those toasted brioche and apricot flavours.

21. Armand De Brignac, Ace Of Spades (France)

Marvellously complex and full bodied, fresh and lively bouquet, sumptuous and racy fruit character.
